The City Council took the following actions at the August 19, 2024, meeting:

- Heard a presentation from Johnson County Chairman Mike Kelly on the proposed homeless services center.
- 2. Proclaimed August 21, 2024 as Fentanyl Prevention and Awareness Day in the City of Gardner.
- 3. Held a public hearing for the purpose of receiving comments to a request for a Waiver of the Distance Limitation to allow for the sale and consumption of Cereal Malt Beverages for consumption within 200 feet of a school, church or library during Tailgate Tastings at Celebration Park.
- 4. Approved the minutes as written for the regular meeting on August 5, 2024. (Passed unanimously)
- 5. Approved City expenditures prepared July 31, 2024 in the amount of \$85,938.20; August 1, 2024 in the amount of \$184,984.08; and August 8, 2024 in the amount of \$874,528.95. (Passed unanimously)
- 6. Authorized a recommendation to award a Progressive Design-Build contract to the Joint Venture Burns & McDonnell/CAS Constructors for a new Hillsdale Intake Structure (Passed unanimously)
- 7. Authorized a recommendation to implement Master Plan Generation Options. (Passed unanimously)
- 8. request for a Waiver of the Distance Limitation and a special event permit to allow for the distribution of samples of cereal malt beverages, wine and spirits within 200 feet of a school, church or library during Tailgate Tastings to be held September 7, 2024 at Celebration Park. (Passed unanimously)
- 9. Authorized the City Administrator to execute an inter-fund loan from the Electric Fund to the Airport Fund. (Passed unanimously)
- 10. Authorized the execution of a real property purchase and sale agreement with Mike and Debbie Gardner to acquire private property adjacent to Gardner Municipal Airport. (Passed unanimously)
- 11. Adopted an ordinance authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$3,700,000 to pay the cost of certain water system improvements, all pursuant to Charter Ordinance No. 28 of the City of Gardner, Kansas. (Passed unanimously)
- 12. Authorized the purchase of a 161kV Circuit Breaker for Substation 4 CIP Project EL4005. (Passed unanimously)
