

# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

It is recommended that if you are a first time visitor to the Gardner Aquatic Center, that you familiarize your family with the following rules prior to your visit. To view a complete listing of the Gardner Aquatic Center Rules and Regulations, please visit our website at www.gardneraquatics.com

- Air temperature must be 72 degress outside at the time of opening.
- To help us assure your child's safety, children ages 11 and under must be accompanied by a person 14
- All persons entering the pool enclosure, including supervising adults, must pay the appropriate fees.
- Individuals who are under the influence of drugs or alcohol, or those using profanity or demonstrating erratic behavior, will not be granted entry.
- In case of rash, skin disease or open sores, a written statement from a physician will be required before admission is granted.
- Please do not enter the water if you have diarrhea to avoid spreading infectious germs. This is especially important for children in diapers.
- Coolers, jugs, food or beverages may not be brought into the facility, excluding private pool parties and

# **Gardner Aquatic Center Pass Policy**

### **Family Passes**

Family Passes are for up to five\* immediate family members living in the same household only. Immediate family is defined as: Two adults and their children, and/or stepchildren age 23 and under living at home. Dependents age 18-23 must be fulltime students. \*If more than five in a family, \$15 per person will be charged.

If an aunt, uncle or grandparent is the legal guardian of the child(ren), then they would be included; however, proof of guardianship and residency is required. If they are not the legal guardian, they would not be considered immediate family. Family members such as nieces, nephews and cousins are not eligible to be on the family's pass.

#### Adult Passes

An adult pass may be purchased for any adult ages 19-61 years.

#### **Youth Passes**

A youth pass may be purchased for ages 3-18 years. NOTE: Children ages 11 and under must be accompanied by someone at least 14 years of age.

Families who employ a nanny/babysitter who is 14 or older may purchase one nanny pass in addition to their family or youth pass for \$70.00 (Limit one nanny pass per household.) Nanny Pass must be purchased in conjunction with a family or youth pass. Pass is only valid for whom pass is issued.

# **Private Swimming Lessons** Age: 5 and older

### Maximum participants: 30

This is your chance to receive that extra special one-on-one instruction. Our certified instructors will help improve those important swimming skills at all levels. Private lessons will be offered for those 5 and older. Children and adults are encouraged to sign up for this program.

Private Lessons will be scheduled during Session I (June 5-15) and registration begins April 1. There will be limited dates and times available for other sessions. These will be on a first-comefirst-served basis. Each student's schedule will be arranged with the Swim Lesson Coordinator. Expect to receive a call from the Swim Lesson Coordinator the week prior.

## Parent/Toddler

Age: 18 mos. to 4 years

Maximum number of participants is 15 in the morning classes and 8 in the evening classes.

Eight 30-minute classes \$65.00 per child Children must be 18 months old as of July 31, 2024. This

class is designed for the parent and toddler. The class will focus on getting the children familiar with the water, ways to hold your child in the water, and preparation for Fins 1. With parent interaction, our certified lifeguards will teach swimming readiness through blowing bubbles, working on back float skills and the beginning of front crawl. Your child will gain coordination and confidence in the water.

- Using the feet first surface dive, retrieve brick from 6 foot depth

- using 3-step approach with dives

- Using the feet-first surface dive, retrieve brick from 12 foot
- Refine 3-step approach from boards, used with all
- Refine tuck and pike dives
- Treading water using all 3 kicks, 8 minutes continuous
- Lifesaving and water safety skills
