## Summer 2017 Positions and Required Qualifications

**\*Pool Manager** – Primary responsibilities include oversight of all operations at the Gardner Aquatics Facility; employee schedules, money handling, maintenance, training and evaluation of employees, directly supervising 100+ employees. Must obtain Red Cross Training Certification. Up to \$8,500.00 season.

**\*Assistant Pool Managers** – Primary responsibilities include assisting the Manager, oversight of daily operations and staff, money handling, pool cleanliness and some staff training. May be asked to receive Red Cross Lifeguard Training Certifications. Must become certified through Red Cross. Red Cross Certification provided by Gardner Parks and Recreation at no cost to the employee. \$11.75 per hour.

**\*Swimming Lesson Coordinator** – Must become certified through Red Cross Training. Red Cross Certification provided by Gardner Parks and Recreation at no cost to the employee. Must have experience with teaching swimming lessons. \$11.75 per hour.

**\*Lifeguards** – Must be at least 15 years of age. Must become certified through Red Cross Lifeguard Training. Red Cross Certification provided by Gardner Parks and Recreation at no cost to the employee. \$9.25 per hour.

**\*Swim Lesson Instructors** - Must be at least 15 years of age. Must become certified through Red Cross Training. \$9.25 per hour. Red Cross Certification provided by Gardner Parks and Recreation at no cost to the employee.

**\*Pool Facility Attendants** – Must be at least 14 years of age. Primary duties include working tube huts, lazy river, slides and cashiering. \$7.50 per hour.

**\*Pool Maintenance** - Must be at least 15 years of age. Primary responsibilities include cleaning swimming pools, decks, drains and restroom facilities. Must be available for weekends. \$10.00 per hour.

**\*Concession Workers** – Must be at least 14 years of age. Responsibilities include food sales at the Gardner Aquatics Center and/or sports complex. Applicants should possess good math and customer service skills. \$7.50 per hour.

**\*Facility Supervisors** – Must be at least 18 years of age. Work in the evenings, 2 to 3 nights per week, Monday thru Sunday. Occasional weekends are required, those hours generally being during the day. Primary responsibilities include supervising baseball and softball games at the Celebration Park and Westside Park Sports Complexes located in Gardner. General knowledge of baseball and softball rules a plus. Must be able to handle difficult situations and work well under pressure. \$11.25 per hour.

**\*Soccer Officials**— Must be at least 14 years of age. Primary responsibilities include officiating youth soccer games; working mostly weekends. General knowledge of soccer rules is a must. Applicants must provide their own uniform and attend mandatory training sessions. \$14-\$20 per game depending on league.

**\*Umpires** – Must be at least 14 years of age. Primary responsibilities include umpiring baseball and/or softball games; working 1 to 5 nights a week, some weekends are possible. General knowledge of baseball/softball rules is a must. Applicants must provide their own uniform and attend a mandatory training session. \$20-\$35 per game depending on league.

**\*Park Maintenance Seasonal** – Must be at least 18 years of age and possess a valid driver's license. Must be available for evening and weekend hours. Primary responsibilities include activities such as mowing, landscaping, athletic field preparations, and other park maintenance duties. \$10.75 per hour.
