

RESOLUTION NO. 1933

A RESOLUTION WITHDRAWING THE CITY OF GARDNER'S EXERCISE OF THE STATUTORY EXEMPTION PROHIBITING THE CONCEALED CARRY OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE GARDNER CITY HALL.

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2013, the City Council pursuant to Section 2(i) of the Personal and Family Protection Act ("PFPA"), Senate Substitute for House Bill 2052, K.S.A. 75-7c20(i), by an approved motion, directed the City Administrator to send a letter to the Kansas Attorney General advising that the City was exercising the four year exemption for the Gardner City Hall building from the PFPA concealed carry provisions;

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to rescind the exercise of the exemption from the concealed carry provisions of the PFPA;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Gardner, Kansas:

SECTION ONE: The City's exercise of the exemption from the PFPA's concealed carry provisions for the Gardner City Hall building is hereby rescinded. City staff is hereby directed to take all actions necessary to allow for compliance with the provisions of the PFPA related to non-exempt buildings including the removal of signage prohibiting the carrying of firearms within City Hall.

SECTION TWO: The City Administrator is hereby directed to advise the Kansas Attorney General by written correspondence that the City of Gardner has rescinded the exercise of the statutory exemption provided for under K.S.A. 75-7c20(i) for the Gardner City Hall.

SECTION THREE: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
